BRING FROM HOME:

- Bucket(s) with lids for clay slop & clay storage
- Specialty tools

DAILY:

- Sign the sign in/sign out indicating what equipment you will be using
- Pay Open Studio fee to AAC staff member when you arrive
- Clean up all areas everyday after use: AAC staff gives a 15 minute warning before end of Open Studio
 Time for cleanup to begin - Late Clean-Up or Space Left Messy results in \$25 penalty charge

EQUIPMENT USE:

- Those unfamiliar with equipment are encouraged to learn proper usage in a class/workshop
- If you can demonstrate knowledge of proper equipment usage to AAC staff, you are permitted to it's use
- Wheels are numbered next to their power button please indicate which wheel you choose in the "equipment used" column on the sign in/sign out sheet
- Always let the AAC staff member know when you will be using the extruder & slab roller

SHELVING & STORAGE:

- Open Studio participants are limited to the community "Open Studio" shelves provided by the AAC. Space is limited. The "Class Storage" Shelves are for Ceramics Class/workshop participants only.
- The Appalachian Artisan Center is not responsible for lost or stolen clay pieces.
- Blue cabinet lockers are are included with \$100 Monthly Unlimited Rental **OR** for \$25/month
- Private Artist Studios are available for rent \$75/month (does not include access to clay studio or equipment). Studios include sink, workstation, lamp, rolling chair, storage locker, safe, fan, and heater.

CLAY:

- Clay can be purchased separately at the AAC
- Each Clay Wash Station is restricted to a particular clay body to avoid the mixing of low/high fire clays and red/whiteware clays
- At this time, the Artisan Center only fires mid-range clay.
- Low range clays may be fired to bisque with our mid range bisque clays but low range glaze firings will only be done separately and at the full kiln price.

MARKING YOUR WORK:

- You must put a mark or signature on the bottom of your work so that it can be identified by staff
- All bisque/glazed wares left on Open Studio shelves for more than 1month will be discarded unless we
 are notified by the owner of extenuating circumstances. Staff (at their discretion) may box up unclaimed
 bisque/glazed wares as it awaits pickup

GLAZING:

- A selection of commercial glazes can be purchased from AAC in 2oz. and greater portions
- Glaze must be wiped off the bottom of all pieces. Any piece with glaze on the bottom WILL NOT be fired. It is your responsibility to clean the pieces before placing them on the "Glaze" shelf
- If a kiln shelf is damaged by running glazes or other issues, replacement of the shelf will be required.

FIRING: ALL kilns are loaded, fired, and unloaded by AAC staff only

- Kiln Request Forms are located under the Kiln Calendar and should be submitted to AAC staff
- Rolling ware carts are labeled Low-Fire and High-Fire with labeled shelves (greenware / bisque / glazeware) put all work onto their respective shelves with a copy of your Kiln Request Form
